

Senior Living Residences Residents & Staff Among First in Nation to Receive Covid Vaccine

Update: 12/18/2020

The CDC (Centers for Disease Control) has recommended that residents and employees of senior living communities be among the first to receive a COVID-19 vaccine along with the nation's essential workers. This is VERY good news.

Through an arrangement with the local Health Department, the vaccine will be administered in clinics conducted in our local Communities starting as early as December, or possibly into the beginning of January. The timeline has yet to be released to Communities.

With this vaccine, seniors and their families can rest more easily knowing our communities offer a very safe place to live for the foreseeable future. We will continue to follow all public health directives concerning social distancing and mask wearing, as well as our own robust safety protocols, including screening, testing, deep cleaning and sanitizing to keep everyone safe (residents, staff and visitors).
