- February 1st marks the Lunar New Year, also known as Chinese New Year. This is the Year of the Tiger!

- February 12th is Abraham Lincoln's Birthday. The 16th president of the United States was born in a one-room, 16by-18-foot, log cabin with a dirt floor.
- February 14th is always Valentine's Day, so spread the love to your family, friends and neighbors!
- February 21 brings Presidents' Day. This is a federal holiday also known as Washington's Birthday that is celebrated on the third Monday in February. (George Washington's actual birthday is February 22nd.)

- February, March, and November always start on the same day of the week unless it is a leap year.
- The Beatles made their first American television appearance on the "Ed Sullivan Show" in February 1964. Over 73 million Americans watched!
- February is Black History Month, celebrated for over 40 years. The Library of Congress, National Archives and Records Administration, National Endowment for the Humanities, National Gallery of Art, National Park Service, Smithsonian Institution and United States Holocaust Memorial Museum join in paying tribute to the generations of African Americans who struggled with adversity to achieve full citizenship in American society.
- February is the United States' snowiest month, on average, according to data from the National Weather Service.
- The Full Snow Moon, February's full moon, reaches peak illumination at 11:59 a.m. on Wednesday, February 16th. Look skyward on that night to catch the best view of this full Moon!

A Note from Dave...A Fabulous February Awaits Us!

February, the month of love. Its mostly recognized for Valentine's Day and being our third month of winter but February has a lot of of interesting facts that make it more than just an ordinary month.

February, as we all know, is the month that fluctuates between 28 and 29 days and the 29th only occurs every four years during the "leap years." The odds of being born on a leap year are 1 in 1461. Those born on the 29th are called "leapers." Our next leap year will be in 2024. Interestingly, throughout history, the length of February has kept changing and at one point it had as little as 23 days. In the Northern hemisphere, where we live, February is the final month of winter, while in the Southern Hemisphere it is the last month of summer! February is the equivalent of August.

The name February comes from the Latin word "februum," which means "purification." The Romans used to have a purification ritual which was like an early Spring Cleaning festival. February was the last month added to the Roman Numeral Calendar.

February is also Black History Month, which began as Negro History Week. The observance coincides with the

birthday of Abraham Lincoln (February 12th), who issued the Emancipation Proclamation and that of Fredrick Douglass (February 14th), an African American Abolitionist who was an author and orator. Black communities across the nation celebrated this week together since the late 19th century. As early as the 1940's some black communities had already transformed February into Black history month. By the 1960s, with the American Civil Rights movement, Negro History Week had had become Black history month in many places other than black communities. In 1976, President Gerald Ford officially recognized February as Black History Month and all subsequent presidents have done the same.

One more interesting fact about February is the difficulty in spelling the month. It is one of the most misspelled words in the entire English language.

I cannot wait for spring but I do not wish any of these February days away. It is the month of love and I hope we all give and receive plenty love this month. I look forward to another great month with you guys!
